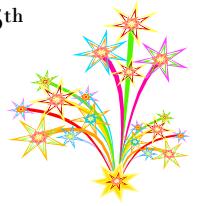

## LIFE LINE SCREENING

Are you, or have you ever been a smoker? Are you a male over 55? St. Mary is pleased to host a Life Line Screening preventative health event to scan for risk of an abdominal aortic aneurysm. Life Line Screening uses ultrasound technology to detect an enlargement or weak area in the main blood vessel that carries blood from the heart to the rest of the body. Warning signs often go unidentified and if ruptured, abdominal aortic aneurysms are 80-95% fatal. The screening will be held on Tuesday, July 27, 2010. The package cost is \$139 & takes just over 1 hour to complete the testing. Pre-register today by calling 888-653-6441.
